

Vista-Patch for PONS

Important: you have to be logged in as an administrator on your computer to install the patch successfully!

Step 1: prepare the patch

1. Insert the PONS CD-ROM into your CD-ROM drive. Do not start the installation.
2. Download the patch (Datei 2: *ponsvista.exe*) and save it locally on your computer.
3. Right-click on the downloaded patch and select the option "Properties" from the dropdown menu. In the "Properties" go to the section "Compatibility" and activate / deactivate following options:
 - Compatibility mode: activate 'Run this program in compatibility mode for *Windows XP (Service Pack 2)*'
 - Settings: deactivate 'Disable visual themes' and 'Disable desktop composition'
 - Privilege level: activate 'Run this program as an administrator'

Step 2: install the program

1. Start the installation by clicking on the thus adjusted patch. If you get a warning that an unidentified program is starting - click on 'Accept'.
2. Click on 'Next' to go to the computer drive selection screen.
3. Make sure that the PONS CD-ROM is in your CD-ROM drive and click on 'Select'. Now select the *install.exe* file from the PONS CD-ROM and click on 'Next'. Please note that the installation will only be successful if you select the correct drive with the PONS CD-ROM.
4. Select the program you want to install and click on 'Next'.
5. Follow the instructions on screen to successfully install your program.

Step 3: exchange the .exe file

1. Download the .exe file (Datei 3: *gkanfdaf.exe*) and save it locally on your computer.
2. Copy the downloaded .exe file into the folder 'Client' that you find in the install folder of your course (the default install folder is: C:\Programme\pons\GKAnfaenger\GKAnfDaF\win32\Client). By copying the .exe file into that folder you will replace the original .exe file.

Step 4: start the program

1. Now you can start the course using the shortcut in the START menu.
2. If your firewall is active you might get a popup asking whether the following programs should be allowed access: 'Futuna Frontend Host.exe' and 'javaw.exe'. Allow access for both programs.
